9:00 am - Dr. Carl Lessard - National Co-ordinator of Animal Genetics Resources

Carl Lessard received his B.Sc in Biochemistry from University Laval in 1994. He completed a master degree in Experimental Medicine at University Laval in 1998. After receiving his PhD in Physiology and Endocrinology in 2003, he completed a fellowship in the field of genetic at The Jackson Laboratory, Maine, USA. In 2006, he joined Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada (AAFC) to start a new program called "Canadian Animal Genetic Resources (CAGR)". This program is a joint initiative between AAFC and University of Saskatchewan. His lab facilities are currently located at the Western College of Veterinary Medicine (WCVN), SK. Dr Lessard was named curator of the CAGR in May 2014 and he is also an adjunct professor at the department of Veterinary Biomedical Sciences of WCVN. His interests are related to spermatogenesis, fertilization processes, embryology, and genetics. He is currently working to develop methods to collect and bank germplasm from different livestock and poultry.
