

BILL OF SALE

A proper Bill of Sale must be drawn up to eliminate any misunderstandings between the seller and the purchaser of an animal. The Bill of Sale must contain the following items:

1. The full description of the animal, breed, sex, tattoo and physical markings.
2. The animal's registered name, registration number and percentage purebred.
3. The purchase price outlining all terms of payment.
4. The physical condition of the animal.
5. Terms and date of delivery of the animal and the registration paper. Also state who pays for the delivery.
6. The name and address of both parties.
7. The Bill of Sale shall be dated and signed by both parties.
8. Itemize any special agreements.
