

Canadian Junior Shorthorn Association Ian McRae Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship Conditions:

- 1) Applicants must be a Canadian Junior Shorthorn Association member.
- 2) Two scholarships will be awarded yearly in the amounts of \$1000 for first and \$500 for second.
- 3) The scholarship shall be used at a recognized post secondary or graduate educational institution.
- 4) If applicant is under 17 years of age, the scholarship will be held in trust by the Canadian Shorthorn Association.
- 5) Unsuccessful applicants may re-apply in subsequent years if they meet the requirements.
- 6) Junior membership fee of \$15.00 (PLUS GST/HST) must be paid to the CSA for the calendar year.
- 7) You must be in your second semester of post secondary school to receive your scholarship money and you must provide your student ID number and a copy of your transcript.
- 8) Applications must be neat and legible. .
- 9) Deadline for applications is November 1.
- 10) Please submit a photo with your application.
